No, they aren't.

5) I am tired.

I am not tired.

Am I tired?

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

6) They are at school.

They are not at school.

Are they at school?

Yes, they are.

No, they aren't.

7) They are from Spain.

They are not from Spain.

Are they from Spain?

Yes, they are.

No, they aren't.

8) He's my English teacher.

He's not my English teacher.

Is he my English teacher?

Yes, he is.

No, he isn't.

9) I am a student.

I am not a student.

Am I a student?

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

10) She is from Russia.

She isn't from Russia.

Is she from Russia?

Yes, she is.

No, she isn't.

11) We are happy.

We are not happy.

Are we happy?

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

12) Steve is nine years old.

Steve is not nine years old.

Is Steve nine years old?

Yes, he is.

No, he isn't.

13) My name is Clara.

My name is not Clara.

Is my name Clara? **Yes, it is.** **No, it isn't.**

14) You are Italian.

You are not Italian.

Are you Italian?

Yes, I am.

No, I am not.

15) Your teacher is British.

Your teacher is not British.

Is your teacher British?

Yes, she is.

No, she isn't.

16) 62 is a great class.

62 is not a great class.

Is 62 a great class?

Yes, they are.

No, they aren't.
