Present Continuous Tense

FORM: am / is / are + ing

USE: now/ at the moment/ Look!/ Listen!/ Be quiet!

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative – Full Form	Negative – short form
I am playing You are playing	Am I playing? you play.....?	I am not playing You are playing	I'm not play..... You aren't
He playing She playing It play.....	Is he playing? she play.....? it?	He not play..... She is play..... It playing	He isn't She play..... It play.....
We are playing You playing They playing	Are we? you? they?	We not playing You play..... They not playing	We play..... You play..... They aren't

Questions and short answers.

Am I playing?	-	Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.
Are you playing?	-	Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.
Is he playing?	-	Yes, he is. / No, he
Is she playing?	-	Yes, she / No, she
Is it playing?	-	Yes, it / No, it
Are we playing?	-	Yes, you / No, you
Are you playing?	-	Yes, we / No, we
Are they playing?	-	Yes, are. / No, aren't.

SPELLING RULES



Words with one Syllable

- Verbs that end in -e (make / write etc.) → *ing*:
make → making write → writing drive → driving
- Sometimes a word ends in a vowel + a consonant. For example: get, run, swim.
Before adding -ing, the consonant at the end is 'doubled'.
get → getting run → running swim → swimming
- Do NOT double the letter if the word ends in two consonants.
help → helping talk → talking work → working
- Do NOT double the letter if the word ends in two vowels + a consonant.
look → looking read → reading speak → speaking
- Do NOT double the letter if the word ends in -w or -x or -y
snow → snowing fix → fixing buy → buying

we use "be" + "ing" verbs

I am walking.
She is talking.
He is laughing.
It is raining.
They are singing.
We are cooking.
You are smiling.



Present Continuous Negative
we use "be" + "not" + "ing" verbs

I am not walking.
She is not talking.
He is not laughing.
It is not raining.
They are not singing.
We are not cooking.
You are not smiling.



Present Continuous Question
We use "be" followed by "Pronoun or subject"

Am I walking?
Is she talking?
Is he laughing?
Is it raining?
Are they singing?
Are we cooking?
Are you smiling?
